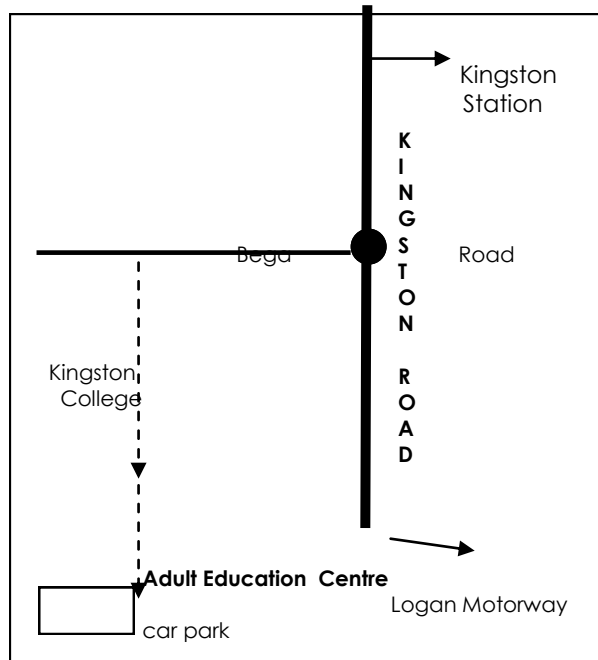

What does KLC Offer?

Kingston Learning College, which is part of the Kingston College campus, provides an opportunity to study senior subjects towards a Queensland Certificate of Education (QCE).

Students can spread their senior studies over a number of years, full-time or part-time. The number of subjects that you will need to complete varies according to your age and goals.

QUEENSLAND CERTIFICATE OF EDUCATION (QCE)

To achieve a QCE applicants must pass 5 subjects for a total of 20 points (4 points per 4 unit subject).

For each subject successfully completed **QCAA** will issue an official Statement of Attainment.

A provisional Senior Statement of Attainment will be issued at Graduation.

ENTRANCE TO TERTIARY INSTITUTIONS

Students should consult with the appropriate tertiary institution for entry requirements and information.

Students who complete 4 General and 1 Applied subject may be eligible for an ATAR.

Some applicants over 19 can also sit the Special Tertiary Admissions Test (STAT).
